GENERAL PUBLIC CHANGES	
Athletic Facilities / Gyms	May 11 th – Facilities may open with restrictions. No locker room or shower access. Detailed State Guidelines
Close Contact Services (Salons, Barber shops, tattoo parlors, massage services)	May 11 th – May open but must maintain 6ft social distancing and sanitation guidelines. Detailed State Guidelines
Individuals	Apr 30 th – Individuals are still encouraged to stay home, practice social distancing in public and encouraged to wear face coverings when in public
Medical Procedures	Apr 30 th – Non-emergency dental, medical, and surgical procedures may resume.
Non-Work Gathering	May 11 th – No size restriction, but must maintain 6 ft social distancing other than immediate family members. Guidelines for religious facilities.
Restaurants / Bars	May 11 th – May open at 50% capacity and maintain social distancing guidelines. Detailed State Guidelines
Retail Stores	Apr 30 th – All retail stores can open but must remain below 50% occupancy capacity, maintain social – distancing and follow CDC sanitation guidelines. Business owners can check their occupancy capacity by contacting the Fire Marshall at 205-444-7606.

Municipal Courts	June 2 nd - Resume court operations
Hoover Neighborhood Parks	May 13 th – Walking tracks and restrooms open; Playground equipment remains closed.
Hoover Recreation Center	May 13 th – The following areas will be open: Game Room, Nursery, Pool, Fitness Center, Track, Cardio Room, Personal Training, Personal Cardio and Restrooms. Hours: 8am – 9:30pm Mon – Thurs; 8am – 9pm Fri; 8am – 6pm Sat; 1pm – 6pm Sun

Educational Institutions	No in-person instruction
Entertainment Venues	Remain closed
Hoover Senior Center	Remain closed; Meals on Wheels continues
Hoover Sports Park	All sports facilities remain closed
Hospitals/Nursing homes	Restrictive visitation
