The meeting was called to order by the Council President, Gary Ivey. The City Clerk had roll call and a quorum was present.

Mr. Ivey stated the purpose of this special meeting was to canvass the results of the April 27, 2010 Special Municipal School Tax Election.

The clerk read Resolution No. 4416-10. The clerk stated one provisional ballot box would be opened and only one ballot would be counted from that box. The clerk opened the box and the ballot envelope. The one (1) vote was **AGAINST** the extension of the 24 mill tax. The total votes, including the one (1) provisional vote, were **3,690 FOR** and **1,339 AGAINST**.

Mr. Wright made a motion to approve **Resolution No. 4416-10**. This motion was seconded by Mr. Skelton. On voice vote the motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
