PROPOSITION

Shall the 24 mills of the ad valorem tax presently being levied by the City of Hoover, Alabama, pursuant to the general provisions of the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama (which 24 mills are for public school purposes), on each dollar of taxable property in the City for each consecutive tax year of the City until and including the tax year for which municipal taxes become due and payable on October 1, 2027, continue to be levied annually commencing with the tax year for which municipal taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2028, and for the 18 consecutive tax years next succeeding thereafter, in continuation of the tax approved at an election held in the City on May 12, 1998?

- FOR continued levy of said 24 mills of taxation for each successive tax year of the City of Hoover commencing with the tax year for which municipal taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2028, and for 18 years thereafter, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Hoover City Board of Education for public school purposes
- AGAINST continued levy of said 24 mills of taxation for each successive tax year of the City of Hoover commencing with the tax year for which municipal taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2028, and for 18 years thereafter, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Hoover City Board of Education for public school purposes
